

Where to Start Your Seeds



Which Seeds should be started indoors?

Crops that have a longer growing season or are susceptible to cold temperatures need a head start. Examples include basil, chard, cilantro, eggplant, peppers, & tomatoes. Transplant outdoors in the warm season.



Which Seeds should be direct-sown outdoors?

Most crops do best when sown directly into the garden soil and not transplanted or disturbed. There are cool-season vegetables which are hardy and warm-season types that are more tender and love warm soil.

> AVERAGE last frost for 10588 is May 5th Extremely safe from frost after May 15th

> > cool-season

very hardy: can be planted 4-6 weeks before last frost date like lettuce & peas March 22 - April 5

hardy: can be planted 2-3 weeks before last frost like carrots & chard April 15 - April 22

warm-season

tender: can be planted 0-2 weeks AFTER last frost date like corn & zucchini May 5 - May 19th
